RULES FOR THE RED WILLOW CO. FAIR*2026*

- **ADMISSION** to the fairgrounds and exhibits will be FREE. However, the Fair Board reserves the right to reject unworthy exhibits of any or all kinds, and to refuse display space or admission to the fairgrounds.
- **ALL** possible diligence and care will be used to prevent loss or injury to animals, articles, or persons on the fairgrounds. It is, however, hereby stipulated that the Fair Board will in no way be responsible for loss or injury of any kind.
- **ENTRIES** may be made in the Open Class by any resident of Red Willow County or by Nebraska residents in adjoining counties bordering Red Willow Co. Nebraska counties eligible are Red Willow, Frontier, Furnas. All articles must be the work of the exhibitor. All work must be completed. EXHIBITS shown in 4-H will not be eligible for Open Class competition. **Only one** entry may be made under each class number. Entries can NOT be or have been shown in any other fair.
- **OPEN CLASS** competitors must have an exhibitor's number to receive premium money and be entered in accordance with the established sections and classes. For judging, please do not put your names directly on your article, just the entry tag.
- **ALL EXHIBITS** must remain in the building during the fair, except by permission of the President of the Fair Board, or O.C. Superintendent.
- **ARTICLES PREVIOUSLY ENTERED, in prior years or in other county fairs**, cannot be entered for premiums in this year's fair. No article may compete for more than one premium.
- **ALL BAKED GOODS AND EXTRA VEGETABLES WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY DONATED TO THE BAKE SALE UNLESS OTHERWISE REQUESTED AT CHECK IN.**
- **PLEASE** make the effort to have all projects FRESH (free of smoke smell), CLEAN and NEAT!
- **OPEN CLASS EXHIBITS** will be released and premium money paid, Sunday, July 26, 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. Exhibits not picked up at this time, can be picked up on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday, following the fair. The Fair Board will not be responsible for articles left after check out time. Any item left longer than one week, will be discarded.
- **ARTIST OR WORKMANSHIP RECOGNITION** (on request) - The entry will not be judged, and a card with the exhibitor's name will be placed on the article. These will be displayed in a special area. **NO BUSINESS CARDS** will be displayed with entries.
- **NUDE ART** can be entered to be judged but will not be displayed.

OPENING TIME**ENTERING**PREMIUMS

◆**THE OPEN CLASS BUILDING** will be open from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday (July 22-24). Saturday the 25th 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.. There will be a Superintendent in the exhibit building at all times that it is open.

◆**OPEN CLASS ENTRIES** (except Poultry Barn) will be made on Tuesday the 21st from 9:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m., and 6:00-7:30 p.m. These entries must be made in the following manner:

1. Report to the **COMMUNITY BUILDING** with a filled in entry tag and receive an exhibitor's number from the Open Class Superintendent. Entry tags are available at the Fair Board office any time.
2. Report to the Superintendent of each section and enter your exhibits.
3. A Pee Wee Division has been created for ages 8 and under. *Please mark clearly on entry tags if it is in the Pee Wee division so that judges will be aware of the age. There is a Junior category for ages 9-16. The adult division is 17 and older. **JUDGING WILL BE DONE INDIVIDUALLY ON MERIT. (New in 2025) Best of Show ribbon will be awarded in all three age divisions.**
4. **POULTRY, RABBIT, AND PIGEON** entry tags must be registered in advance - They are due in the Fair office by July 15, 2026. On Tuesday, July 21, between 5:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m., bring your animals directly to the Poultry Building. The animals will be released Saturday evening at 10:00 p.m.

◆**PREMIUM** amounts for placing of purple, blue and red will be listed in this Open Class book and will be paid CASH when the exhibits are released. These premiums will not be mailed out. Should premiums exceed the amount of money available, the Fair Board reserves the right to prorate the premiums to the amount available. In case there is one single entry in a class, the judge may decide whether or not the article is worthy of a premium.

The manager of the Fair Board shall have the supervision of the fairgrounds, allot space for the different concessions, assign places for encampments, and preserve order and decorum. Any disputes not settled by Fair officials may be referred to the Red Willow County Fair Board.

The promiscuous distribution of handbills or other advertising matters is strictly prohibited, and no tacking or posting of advertising bills, cards, etc., will be permitted on any of the buildings or other structures. Exhibitors may advertise and distribute from their place of exhibit only. No vehicle will be allowed to park in the parking areas for the sole purpose of advertising.

The class Superintendent shall have supervision of all animals or articles in his class. He/She will also see that they are conveniently arranged for examination by the judges and the public, and furnish information relevant to the exhibition.

The committee or judge shall hand their reports to the Superintendent of their department as soon as the decision is made. Those reports should embody as much general information in reference to the article or animal examined as the time and circumstances will permit. The Superintendent will then turn them into the Fair Clerk in the fair office.

EXHIBITORS are expected at all times to give necessary attention to what they have on exhibition. Diligence will be used by the Officers to prevent loss or injury, but in no case will the Fair Board be responsible for accidents.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- ◆ **ADVANCE** registration for poultry, rabbits and pigeons will be due in the fair office by July 17, 2026. Poultry, rabbits and pigeons not entered by this date will receive only ½ of the premium money.
- ◆ **FOWL** shown as individuals cannot be included in a pen, pair or trio.
- ◆ **ALL** animals must be taken to the Poultry Barn between 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, July 21, 2026.
- ◆ **DIRTY OR DISEASED** birds will be disqualified and removed from the Poultry Show.
- ◆ You will need to “bring your own feed”-what we have on hand is for **EMERGENCY ONLY**. You will be responsible to **FEED AND WATER** your own animals. Feed and water times are as follows: 8:00-9:00 a.m., 12:00-1:00 p.m. and 4:30-9:30 p.m. Premium money may be withheld if you do not comply.
- ◆ Exhibits shown in 4-H will not be eligible for Open Class competition.
- ◆ **COCK & HEN** must be hatched **PRIOR** to 2026.
- ◆ **COCKEREL & PULLET** must be hatched **DURING** 2026.
- ◆ **STATE THE BREED** on the entry tags for all Poultry, Rabbits and Pigeons.
- ◆ **RELEASE TIME** for Open Class animals will be Saturday evening **at** 10:00 p.m.
- ◆ Your birds may be tested for diseases by a State Veterinarian during the fair. This will be of no charge to you.
- ◆ **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS**

In order to comply with the Nebraska Poultry Disease Act, poultry exhibited are required to meet one of the following qualifications:

- (1.) Must be free from lice and mites
- (2.) Must be in good health condition and clean
